The deBor's Jensen Tech Session


Aeint deBor had asked for a tech session to sort out several problems with their 1974 Jensen Healey. The troubles included a faulty fuel pump, the Jensen's steering column key lock, as well as cleaning up the carb air intake ducting.

Lou Galper, Howard Stark, Udo Putzke, Bob Humphreys were at task when I arrived. Howard was working on the Deloro carburetor air cleaner intake. Udo and Bob were checking out the fuel pump, in the trunk, that was leaking and not getting gas to the carbs. Bob, having experience with his Jensen, went shopping for a new pump and hose. Udo was busy figuring out the fuel pump installation. Lou and I were checking out the coffee and donuts.



By the end of the session the fuel pump problem was solved, With a new one. The carb intake ducting straightened out, and the steering column key lock was working with judicious key-work. It seems that the brass tumbler bushing was worn and in need of additional work, beyond what the tech session could accomplish. The key would turn and the car would start with said judicious jiggling.

A parade of Aeint and Virginia's neighbors came by to see the impromptu Healey car show, followed by some rem-



iniscing of memorable times, and younger days and their MG's and TR's. By early afternoon, of a warm winter day, we left Aeint & Virginia with a drivable Jensen, and us with the right number of fingers, which is always nice...

CAR OF THE YEAR (COTY) AWARD

AHCSD events will have a sign-in sheet that will be forwarded to the recorder. For members with multiple eligible vehicles, be sure to indicate which one(s) you drove.


