February Meeting Minutes

AHCSD March 12, 2025 Meeting

President Laura Leyland called the meeting to order at 7:02 p.m.

Laura Leyland opened the meeting, welcomed all and expressed wishes for a happy St. Patrick's Day. She also apologized for the lateness of the club newsletter due to the Leyland's recent travel. No minutes were yet available for a vote/approval.

Kathleen Reid asked some clarification questions for the club's website project. John Lee (membership) and Lynne Stark (hospitality) agreed to using their emails for contact information. Kathleen will be passing along updated information to the web designer. She is looking at the best way to collect photos for the webpage and considering Dropbox or a Google photo folder.

Laura discussed upcoming Austin Healey drive events that included a Wine tour on 3/22. Rolling British Car Day is coming up on 4/6. 





CALIFORNIA HEALEY WEEK ADD-ON TOUR TO VEGAS

The **British Car Club of Las Vegas** is celebrating their 35th Anniversary in October.. They are organizing an event that has been planned so that those attending California Healey Week can segue to their event. Here are the details.

Friday, October 10: California Healey Week ends with breakfast. Depart Yosemite for **Tonopah**, **NV** via Tioga Pass and Lee Vining, where we will make a lunch stop before continuing the final 2 1/2 hours to Tonopah. Our accommodations will be in the historic **Mizpah Hotel**, built in 1907 and completely refurbished in 2011. We even get a guided tour of this reputed "haunted hotel".

On Saturday we will make our way to the **Red Rock Casino Hotel** outside Las Vegas via historic Beatty and Rhyolite, Nevada arriving in plenty of time to enjoy the hotel's many diversions and great restaurants.

Car of the Year Award Standings

To recognize Club members who participate with their Healey's, the Austin Healey Club of San Diego awards CAR OF THE YEAR (COTY) points for various activities. Opportunities to collect COTY points include any car related events (shows, drives, rallies, etc.) sponsored by an official organization (other car clubs, auto museum, city chambers of commerce, charities, etc.) where you participate with your Healey. Events need not be listed in the Club's newsletter to earn points.

The participant is responsible for providing proof of participation (entrance fee receipt, photo, corroboration from other club members etc.) to the Coty Recorder, Rick Snover (619) 980-4194 smokey.snover@gmail.com within 30 days after the event. AHCSD events will have a sign-in sheet that will be forwarded to the recorder. For members with multiple eligible vehicles, be sure to indicate which one(s) you drove.

CotY points currently approved by the Board are:

- AHCSD Meetings & Tech Sessions 5pts
- AHCSD Driving Events, Parties, etc. 6pts
- California Healey Week, Healey Rendezvous and Austin Healey Conclave 20 pts
- S.D. British Car Day and Rolling B.C.D. 10pts
- Other multi-day British-themed events 8pts
- Other multi-day events 4pts
- Other one-day British-themed events 4pts
- Other one-day events (Cars & Coffee, etc) 1pt. 10 pt limit annually.
- Other non-Healey, British-built cars earn half points, but are not eligible to win the award.

The total point leader at the end of the year will receive the coveted CAR OF THE YEAR badge for display on their Healey for the following year.




